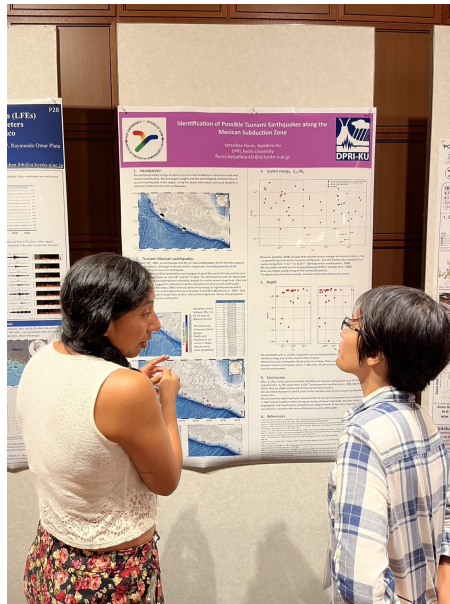


International Joint Workshop Slow-to-Fast Earthquakes 2023 Tokyo, Japan
